Literacy

We will start our English off with a one-off unit based on a familiar story called 'Five Minutes peace' by Jill Murphy. Handwriting, punctuation, grammar and spellings are at the heart of our literacy lessons and the children will be using what they have previously learnt within their writing, plus learning some new vocabulary and spellings. Last week I managed to assess all children in KS1 and have grouped them accordingly. Reading books and contact books will be sent home towards the end of this week. I cannot stress the importance of reading at home, so please aim to read with your children at least 4 times a week. Daily if possible. I have attached a letter about the teaching of Phonics/Reading at Kingston St Mary. Spellings - Zog group — please ignore the spellings that have been sent home. We will start these after half term. Our main focus this term will be letter formation. Gruffalo Group will be tested as of next Monday.
