What is an ELSA?

An ELSA (Emotional Literacy Support Assistant) is a member of staff who is trained to support children in the development of their emotional literacy.

What is emotional literacy?

- Understanding and coping with our feelings about ourselves and others.
- Developing high self-esteem and positive interactions with others.
- Being emotionally literate helps children focus better on their learning.

Some of the areas an ELSA may work on:

- Recognising emotions.
- Self-esteem.
- Social skills.
- Friendship skills.
- Anger management.
- Loss and bereavement.

How does the ELSA work?

- A regular slot during the school week for 30-45 minutes.
- One to one sessions are tailored to the child's individual needs.
- Group sessions, known as Nurture, are also available.
- Sessions are fun and might include: role-play, puppets, board games, art and craft, cooking, gardening and stories.
- Sessions include time to talk.
- A pupil's progress will be reviewed on a regular basis in consultation with parents/carers.

If your child's class teacher thinks that your child may benefit from some ELSA support, either on a one to one or group basis, they will contact you.

As a parent/carer, how can you help?

- By informing your child's class teacher if there are any issues that may be affecting your child.
- Please feel welcome to contact your child's teacher or the ELSA if you have any questions.

I have been into both the Woodpeckers' class and the Robins' class to explain to the children a little bit about my new role as the school's ELSA.

They are aware that there is a special box in the school library that they can put their name into should they wish to talk to me about anything which might be worrying them.
