SCHOOL UNIFORM

We are very proud of our school uniform. It is simple and economic, the logo items can be ordered from our supplier South West Schoolwear, a link to their website is on our school website homepage – www.ksmprimary.com, the other items are available from high street stores.

Main uniform

Trousers	Grey/charcoal (not denim or cord)
Pinafores/skirts	Grey
Polo shirt	White
Sweatshirt or cardigan	Red with school logo
Tights	Grey/black/red
Socks	Boys: black/grey; Girls: white/grey
Summer dress	Red and White
Short trousers	Grey
Shoes/sandals	Sensible black shoes (<u>not trainers or boots</u>)

PE Kit to be worn to school on Fridays

- T-Shirt - Red, Blue, or Green with the school logo
(This corresponds to the tractor group your child has been assigned to.)
- Black shorts - plain
- Daps/trainers – please check fitting periodically (laces only if your child can tie them)
- Black track-suit bottoms or leggings/skins under their shorts.
- Black or red sweatshirt.

During the winter months, if children are taking part in PE **outdoors** they can wear a track-suit: **plain, dark colours without logos**.

Older children may also require football boots or outdoor trainers and shin pads.

There are second hand uniform items available from the PTFA. Please ask a member of staff for details.

A sunhat/cap is recommended for sunny days. Wellies will be needed for our nature walks and for playing on the field.

Book bag – pupils in KS1 will be provided with their first book bag.

Please make sure all items are clearly named

Hair

Must be **neat, tidy** and **natural** in style and colour (no gel, colourings etc.). **Long hair must tied back** to promote hygiene and avoid accidents. Extreme hairstyles which may follow fashion trends are not acceptable.

Jewellery

Jewellery should not be worn at school. Responsibility cannot be accepted for lost items. Children with pierced ears may wear studs (and remove during PE lessons) but decorative earrings should not be worn. Watches may be worn.

Make Up

Make up and nail varnish are not allowed. No tattoos or body art.

Lost Property

This is kept in a box in the school hall. If items are named it is easy to reunite lost items with their owner.
