This is a summary of how our school delivers music education to all our pupils across three areas – curriculum music, co-curricular provision and musical experiences – and what changes we are planning in future years. This information is to help pupils and parents or carers understand what our school offers and who we work with to support our pupils’ music education.

Children receive daily opportunities to sing through a combination of classroom lessons and singing assemblies.

Our music curriculum delivers the requirements of the National Curriculum following units from Charanga Music.

Children learn to play a musical instrument in Years 3 and 4, delivered by a specialist teacher.

Across all year groups, children develop progressive skills in the key areas of Composition & Improvisation, Notation, Listening & Appreciation, Singing, Playing Instruments and Performing.

This is about opportunities for pupils to sing and play music, outside of lesson time, including choirs, ensembles and bands, and how pupils can make progress in music beyond the core curriculum.

Our school currently offers a Choir Club.

Children access guitar lessons through a specialist teacher.

Children with a particular interest in music have opportunity to play instruments and sing during lunchtimes.
