This week has been SATs week for our Year 6 pupils, with children across England completing a range of national assessments. Over the course of the week, the children have taken tests in Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation, Reading Comprehension and Mathematics, following strict Department for Education (DfE) guidelines. Schools are also subject to unannounced monitoring visits to ensure all procedures are followed correctly, including the secure storage of test papers, and we did receive a visit this year.

We work hard to ensure the children feel well prepared while also reminding them that these tests are only one small snapshot of their learning. SATs cannot measure the many qualities that make each child unique, nor do they define who they are. We will remember this Year 6 cohort for being such fantastic role models within our school community, and for the many individual talents, strengths and personalities they bring each day.

We are incredibly proud of the children, who approached the week with maturity, calmness and determination, always trying their very best.

A special thank you goes to Mrs Phelps for all of her hard work in preparing the children for their SATs and for the care and encouragement she has shown throughout the week. Her support included giving the children the opportunity to come into school early each morning to enjoy a special breakfast together, helping them to start each day feeling calm and ready to do their best.
