## School Uniform

School uniform helps to build a sense of identity and community among pupils and with their school. Our uniform is simple and economical. Our policy is in line with government guidance which stipulates that schools should limit the number of compulsory branded items of uniform and PE to three or fewer.

Whilst we have many branded items available, the only compulsory branded item is the PE T-shirt which is a coloured PE shirt to reflect the child's tractor group.

Main Uniform	
<b>Trousers</b>	Grey/charcoal (not denim or cord)
<b>Pinafores/skirts</b>	Grey
<b>Polo shirt</b>	White
<b>Sweatshirt or cardigan</b>	Red with school logo
<b>Tights</b>	Grey/black/red
<b>Socks</b>	Black, grey or white
<b>Summer dress</b>	Red and White
<b>Short trousers</b>	Grey
<b>Shoes/sandals</b>	Sensible black shoes (including all black trainer style footwear) Please do not send your child to school in laced footwear if they are unable to tie the laces.

PE Kit	
<b>T-Shirt</b> (with school logo) Red, Blue, or Green	The colour corresponds to the tractor group your child has been assigned to. You will be informed of this on confirmation of school admission. <b>This is the only item of uniform that we have made compulsory to be branded.</b>
<b>Shorts</b> – plain black	
<b>Daps or trainers</b>	Please check fitting periodically Please do not send your child to school in laced footwear if they are unable to tie the laces.
<b>Sweatshirt</b> – black or red	Children may wear their school sweatshirt.
